NWCG CURRICULUM MANAGEMENT ISSUE PAPER #54 PROPOSAL TO CHANGE THE PASSING SCORE FOR S-260 FROM 70% TO 80% January 8, 2004

BACKGROUND/CURRENT STATUS

S-260, Interagency Incident Business Management is a technical course that requires students to be very accurate in filling out forms and dealing with business issues. Is it O.K. to fill out someone's time sheet with 70% accuracy? Is 70% good enough when figuring fuel and oil costs for an incident? The concepts taught in S-260 are based on the Interagency Incident Business Management Handbook. Given the handbook and real world exercises, it seems reasonable to expect student performance well above the 70% level.

ISSUE

The current NWCG standard of requiring a minimum of 70% to pass the S-260, Interagency Business Management course is too low.

RECOMMENDATION

The S-260 revision group proposes that a minimum score of 80% be required to pass the course.
